

FAQs

Who is eligible to do CIDTL?

You need to be either a full or part time teacher in an educational institution. See **box** for more details

How will the programme unfold?

Research is unambiguous that **blended programmes** are most effective online. CIDTL -online will include **synchronous** faculty-led online sessions, **a synchronous** Interactive video lessons, juxtaposed with periods of **self-study**, **practice** and **peer learning** on faculty moderated Buddylist.

What will be the schedule?

- a. Synchronous faculty -led guided sessions online will be hosted once a fortnight on alternate Saturdays from 3 to 6p.m.
- b. Asynchronous learning will be through Interactive video lessons designed/ curated by Srikriti. These video lessons will be accessible on chosen platforms for a week in between.

The above two are well paced so that you can effortlessly juxtapose the following two modes of blended learning.

Eligibility Criteria

- Part/full time
 Teacher/Leader School/college, training
 /Activity centre.
- 2 Teach in their current institution a minimum of 10 learners and be responsible for planning, teaching and assessing these learners
- Access to a mentor for observation of practice and support
- Access to a laptop with WIFI.
- **c. Self-study** will include reading, research and reflective writing. Srikriti Will support you with resources and curated additional reading materials.
- d. Collaborate/discuss with peers on faculty moderated Buddylist and Srikriti Study Groups (SSGs) at least once a week.
- **e. Work-based** learning includes classroom teaching, observation of practice, learning from an experienced colleague and all the mandatory activities required to complete thee-portfolio.

What is the duration of the diploma programme

In these uncertain times, it's difficult to put a precise

number to this response! However, CIDTL will be approximately 11 months long.

How will I be assessed?

An assignment with a portfolio of artifacts that will be assessed by Cambridge examiners.

What is the course fee?

INR 1,20,000/-per candidate payable in installments.

What are the deliverables from Srikriti?

- Srikriti would take care of all the back end admin support- from enrollment to certification in a seamless smooth loop.
- Besides course delivery and material prescribed by CAIE, Srikriti
 supports learners with additional reading materials required to bridge
 the gaps in our teachers' understanding of contemporary practice,
- All teacher candidates would be part of a moderated e- buddy list to encourage collaborative learning and sharing.
- One of the wash back effect of this course should be interest in reading professional literature. Srikriti would support the learners with reading lists/web links etc
- Srikriti faculties have been much appreciated for their mentoring and supporting skills by CAIE and our candidates. This would be provided through email, telecalls and online sessions as the need arises
- In case candidates failing a module; Srikriti faculty would support them in reworking their assignment with no additional fee except resit fee payable to CAIE at that time.
