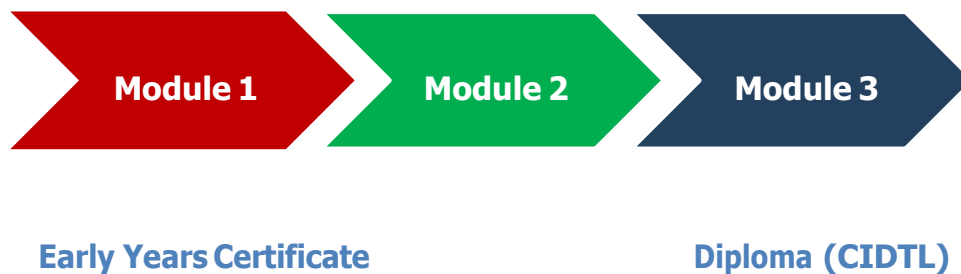




Cambridge Qualification *for Teachers of* Young Learners

The Early Years Certification at a glance

The EY Certificate is a 4 months course from the University of Cambridge and comprises of three units that add up to a module. On completion of this module successfully by fulfilling all the requirements of the course, you will receive **Cambridge International Certification in Early Years Best practice** at a pass or distinction level making you eligible to teach **Early Years** in any International or national programme in schools.

FAQs

1. Who is eligible to do the Cambridge Early Years Certification?

You have to be a full /part-time practitioner employed in an **early year** setting. See **box** for more details. If you are presently not teaching, let us know. Our coordinators will support you.

2. How will the course unfold?

Totally online in a blended mode.

- Synchronous:** faculty –led guided sessions **online** will be hosted once a fortnight on **alternate Saturdays** from **3 to 6 p.m.**
- Asynchronous** learning will be through Interactive **video lessons** designed/curated by Srikriti. The above two are well paced so that you can juxtapose the following two modes of blended learning.
- Self-study** will include reading, research and assignment writing. Srikriti will support you with Cambridge and Srikriti curated additional reading materials.
- Collaborates with peers on **Buddylist** / Srikriti Study Groups
- Work- based** learning includes classroom teaching, observation of practice, learning from an experienced colleague and all the mandatory activities required to complete the e-portfolio for assignment.

3. What is the duration of the EY certification programme?

6 months

4. How will I be assessed?

An assignment with a portfolio of artifacts that will be assessed by Cambridge examiners.

5. What is the Early Years course fee?

INR 70,000/candidate payable in instalments.

6. What does EY certification lead me to?

You can progress to module 2 and 3 of the Diploma in Teaching & Learning (CIDTL) from University of Cambridge (CIAE) making you eligible to teach grade level learners too

7. What is my PDQ pathway after the Diploma ?

The diploma (CIDTL) besides making you eligible to teach grade level opens up pathways to further your PDQs like Med and MA and MBA in Education Management.
